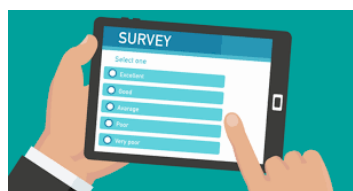
To help with traffic flow, **PLEASE DO NOT
